

# Great Park's antique market shuts ahead of new construction

## SHUT

The Great Park's monthly antique market is no more. The outdoor bazaar of collectibles, antiques and homemade goods - called the **Groves Antique Market** - held its last show June 1 after its month-to-month lease wasn't renewed.

Communities is expected in late June to begin runway demolition and then building out the first of 688 acres into sports fields, trails and a golf course. The upcoming work required the monthly market, which had been on the runway for the past few months, to move.

## ON THE HORIZON

**Orchard Supply Hardware** will open a more than 35,000-square-foot store in the fall at Oak Creek Shopping Center in Irvine. The San Jose-based home improvement chain, acquired by Sears in the 1990s, filed

for bankruptcy in June 2013.

Two months later, competitor **Lowe's** acquired 70-plus Orchard locations for \$205 million in cash. The agreement was Orchard would retain its brand and operate as its own company, Lowe's officials said.

**SoulCycle**, a chain of indoor-cycling studios, will open its first Orange County location this winter at Fashion Island in Newport Beach. The company will occupy a roughly 3,300 square-foot space that will include a bike studio and boutique.

SoulCycle opened its first location in New York City in 2006.
